- 4 Little head (9)
- 5 ligament resists varus stress in the elbow (6,10)
- 7 proximal end of the ulna (9)
- **10** Ligament: Ligament of the superior radioulna joint (7)
- 11 Notch on the lateral side of the proximal ulna (6,5)
- **13** Commonest dislocation of the elbow (9)

- **15** Bursa located within the tendon of the triceps brachii. (14)
- **16** The major extensor of the elbow (7)
- **17** Bursa located between the olecranon and the overlying connective tissue (12)
- 19 The elbow belongs to this class of joints.(5)
- **20** Membranous sac filled with synovial fluid (5)
- **21** Clue (4)

- 1 bursa located between the olecranon and the tendon of the triceps brachii (12)
- 2 originates from the medial epicondyle (5,10)
- **3** Commonest fracture around the elbow (13,8)
- 6 Site of insertion of bicep brachii (6,10)
- 8 Anastomosis around the elbow (7)
- 9 Distal border of the

trochlear fossa of the ulna (8)

- 12 Overuse strain of the common tendinous origin of the extensor muscles of the forearm (6,5)
- 14 Articulations comprising the elbow joint (5)
- **18** Nerve most commonly injured in elbow dislocations (4)
